

# The One Class Period Team Sport Tournament

- First** - Make fair teams. Instruct the students to divide themselves into groups of 5 and to sit down away from other groups. Then have each group sit in a single file row next to each other team. Move yourself to the side of where the groups are sitting. Each column of students is now a team. Each team will have 1 person from the original group of 5. Distribute jerseys.
- Second** - Play the round robin portion of the tournament. See the games listed below and play them in order to provide continuity.
- Third** - Calculate the team rankings. Use the chart below to determine the places.
- Fourth** - Conduct Free Agency. Absorb the fifth place team into the other four teams. 4th picks a player then 3rd, then 2nd, then 1st. The instructor places the remaining players on teams. If one team is left a player short, it should be the top seeded team.
- Last** - Play the three games of the single elimination portion of the tournament.
